- Current AWSA Regular or Senior Judge, Scorer, Driver, Technical Controller, Regional or National Safety Director.
- Current or previous voting member of the AWSA Regional Council

SELECTION RULES FOR EASTERN REGION JUNIOR TEAM MEMBER

- A. General definitions and qualifications for all team members:
 - 1. All team members must be Eastern Region skiers as defined in tournament rules.
 - 2. Junior skiers are skiers in the Boys 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and Girls 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 divisions.
 - 3. Teams will be selected based on performances of the current ski year and named for the ensuing year (the team year) following the completion of the National Tournament.
 - 4. A skier's division is the division in which he/she will be eligible to ski at the next Regionals/Nationals.
 - 5. To maintain his/her position, a skier must be a competitive member of USA Water Ski and Wake Sports for the team year.
- B. Junior Development Team: made up of all junior skiers who ski in the Regionals and/or Nationals.
- C. Exceptions to team selections: Any skier who has qualified for the Regionals/Nationals and is unable to participate due to injury or personal reasons may submit in writing his/her request for exception to the Junior Development Committee no later than two weeks after the completion of the Nationals. The committee chairperson will notify the skier in writing of the decision of the committee.

SELECTION RULES FOR THE EASTERN REGION ALL STAR TEAM

- 1. The team composition is made up of 6 members and 1 alternate.
- 2. The 6 members must be current skiers in the Boys 2, Boys 3, Boys 4, Boys 5, Girls 2, Girls 3, Girls 4 or Girls 5 divisions.
- 3. The skier must be committed to attending and skiing in the National Competition.
- 4. Skiers will be chosen based on their regional seeding* as 60% and their Regional performances as 40%.
- 5. The six-member team may have no more than two team members from the same division. The gender distribution shall be either 3/3 or 4/2 for the 6 members of the Regional All Star Team. The alternate can be from any of the eligible divisions.
- 6. The committee will choose the strongest three eventers first, then the two eventers and finally single eventers.
- 7. If the skier skis in a tournament that is outside of the United States, it is his/her RESPONSIBILITY to send in a copy of their performance record to Jennifer Frederick** if the skier wants that score to be added to their seeding for Regionals. This record MUST be given to Jennifer at least ONE WEEK prior to Regionals in order to be counted.

Eastern Region Water Ski Record Application

Regional Record Guidelines – 2003 & beyond

- These guidelines have been adopted to assure integrity of Eastern Region Water Ski Records. The full set of guidelines are posted in the Policies & Procedures Manual and are viewable on the Eastern Region Website www.AWSAEast.org

There are three types of Eastern Region records:

1. Class C & Above which records can be set in Class C, E, L, & R tournaments, the new Class E, L & R Tournament Records, and Regional's Tournament Records. (Full explanation on the website.)
2. E,L,R records are the highest known E, L, & R scores.
3. Regional Tournament Records are all provisional & are compiled from Eastern Regional's scorebooks

Records will not be approved for "turn and burn" performances. I.e., if a skier elects to ski his/her final round immediately upon completion of the current round and if a Regional record is exceeded in that final round, that final round performance is not eligible to become a Regional record.

All Eastern Region record application submissions (except the Eastern Regional Tournament records) **are the responsibility of the skier.**
