7.3.6 Junior Skiers Travel Reimbursement Policy for skiers selected to represent Team USA in International Competitions

The Council shall annually approve a budget line item amount for Eastern Region Junior travel reimbursement for skiers representing Team USA in international competition.

Eligible skiers include any Eastern Region skier selected to the U14, U17, and/or U21, USA Junior Teams for 3-event international competition sanctioned by the IWWF.

Travel expense is defined as commercial airline flight expenses incurred to attend an international event representing Team USA.

The Eastern Region travel expense reimbursement policy is intended to offset travel expenses for skiers only, and does not include travel expenses incurred by parents, relatives, or chaperones for their related travel.

To receive reimbursement, receipts for skier travel expenses must be submitted to the Eastern Region Treasurer, with a copy to the Eastern Region EVP, within 30 days of the end of the tournament or December 10th, whichever is sooner.

Each skier can submit up to \$500 for reimbursement for commercial airline travel.

In the event multiple skiers in a given calendar year are selected to the USA Junior Team competing internationally, the EVP and Treasurer will divide the amount budgeted by the Council equally among those individual skiers.

The Junior Skiers Reimbursement Policy does not apply to any IWWF Junior World or Junior Pan Am events held within the United States.

The International Activities Committee representative(s) should notify the Team USA skier of the reimbursement policy.

Upon submission of eligible Eastern Region skier expenses, the Eastern Region will reimburse the expense amount to each skier upon approval by the EVP and Treasurer in accordance with this policy.
